DIVISION A. RACING - No Post Entries except to fill heats.

- NO Baskerville Muzzles Allowed.
- Basket Muzzles preferred. Colored Basket and Colored Softies muzzles are NOT allowed. Black, Brown/Tan, Clear or White muzzles are acceptable. Collars should be off when on deck.
- All terriers <u>entering</u> the catch area during a race without a secure muzzle will be disqualified. No request for height measurement once racing has begun. Measurements by 7:45 AM
- Terriers May Not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran & Senior classes.
- To be eligible to run in the Championship race, a terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first thru the backside of the barrier. (01/22). In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second-place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above. (01/20)

<u>Class 41:</u> <u>10-12½" Veteran Championship</u>. Open to 1st place winners of classes 14, 16, 35, 37. No entry fee.

<u>Class 42: Over 12½-15" Veteran Championship</u>. Open to 1st place winners of classes 15, 17, 36, 38. No entry fee.



DIVISION B: CONFORMATION

Section I: YOUTH

- Child Handlers 5-9 years of age. They must handle a six month or older Jack Russell terrier.
- Youth Handlers: 10-16 years of age. <u>The youth handler must handle the same adult terrier</u> in all Youth Division classes entered. No puppies please. See rules for exceptions regarding injured terriers.
- Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year; except for those children turning 5 years of age. They may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5th birthday.
- Child/Youth entries must be JRTCA members either under a family membership or under an individual Youth membership.
- Entry fee is \$12.00 a class. Please list class number, child/youth's name, birthday, and dog's name on entry form.
- The quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Points are 1st=8 pts., 2nd=6 pts., 3rd=5 pts., 4th= 4 pts., 5th=3 pts., 6th= 2 pts., & Participation=1 pt.

<u>Class 43:</u> Child Handler. Open to any youth aged 5 through 9 handling a JRT, six months of age or older. Judged on child's knowledge of the JR and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 44:</u> Youth Handler. Open to any youth aged 10–16 handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's knowledge of the JRT and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 45:</u> Youth GTG. Open to any youth aged 10-16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's ability to present his or her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through the 10-ft. novice liner; time not to be considered.

<u>Class 46:</u> <u>Youth High Score and Reserve</u> will be awarded to the Youth Handlers with the most points in Classes 44 thru 45.

CONFORMATION

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes <u>must submit the appropriate JRTCA Paperwork with entries</u>. The judge may require a copy of The National Hunting Certificate to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Registered terriers may submit a copy of the NHC Application, signed by a JRTCA Working Judge, within 30 days of the date it was issued.
 - Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.

SECTION I. 3-up to 12 MONTH PUPS

<u>Class 47:</u> Pups, 3 up to 4 months (non-sanctioned)

4 up to 6 Mo. PUPS

Class 48: Dog pups, 4 up to 6 months

Class 49: Bitch pups, 4 up to 6 months

Class 50: BEST 4-6 MONTH PUPPY & RESERVE. Open to Best & Reserve of classes 48 & 49.

Section II. 6-12 Month PUPS

Class 51: Dog pups, 6 up to 9 months

Class 52: Dog pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 53: BEST DOG PUP & RESERVE. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 51 & 52.

Class 54: Bitch pups, 6 up to 9 months

<u>Class 55:</u> Bitch pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 56: BEST BITCH PUP & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 54 & 55.

<u>Class 57</u>: <u>PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE</u>. Open to Best Puppy Dog & Reserve and Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve, class 53 & 56.

SECTION III. FAMILY

<u>Class 58:</u> Stud Dog & Get. Open to sire with at least 2, but not more than 3, offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.

<u>Class 59:</u> Brood Bitch & Produce. Open to dam with at least 2, but not more than 3, offspring at side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.

Class 60: BEST FAMILY. Open to first & second place winners of classes 58 & 59. No entry fees

SECTION IV. MISCELLANEOUS

Open to any adult JRT including those spayed and neutered. Judged on breed standard unless otherwise noted.

<u>Class 62</u>: Veteran Dog. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier dog six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition of dog.

<u>Class 63:</u> Veteran Bitch. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier Bitch six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition of dog.

Class 64: BEST VETERAN. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 62 & 63

<u>Class 65:</u> Spayed/Neutered Adult. Open to any spayed/neutered adult.

Class 66: Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier

<u>Class 67:</u> Companion. Open to all JRTS. Judged on companionship, cuteness, personality, obedience, and tricks. Not to be judged on breed standard, non-sanctioned.

Juniors Terriers aged 12-24 months. Terriers can cross enter into open adult conformation or working.

<u>Class 68:</u> Junior Dog (non-sanctioned)

Class 69: Junior Bitches (non-sanctioned)

<u>Class 70:</u> BEST JUNIOR TERRIER & RESERVE Open to 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 68 and 69 (non-sanctioned)

Suitability.

Judge's Choice. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each of the quarry listed below.

Class 72: Suitability to Red Fox

Class 73: Suitability to Groundhog

Class 74: Suitability to Raccoon/Badger.

SECTION V. JRTCA WORKING TERRIERS.

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA NHC. Terriers entering this section may not cross- enter in Open; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working section.

Class 76: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over.

<u>Class 77:</u> Bronze Medallion Dog. Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 78: Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½."

Class 79: Working Terrier Dog, 1 year & over, over 121/2" up to 15."

<u>Class 81</u>: <u>BEST JRTCA WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 76 through 79; no entry fee

Class 82: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over.

<u>Class 83:</u> Bronze Medallion Bitch. Open to any Bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 84: Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½."

Class 85: Working Terrier Bitch, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15."

<u>Class 87: BEST JRTCA WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 82 through 85; no entry fee.

<u>Class 88:</u> <u>JRTCA WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 81 and 87. No entry fees.

SECTION VI. OPEN ADULT

No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section

<u>Class 89:</u> Bred by Exhibitor Dog. Open to any adult JR owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 90: Dogs, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 91: Dogs, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken.

Class 92: Dogs, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15", smooth

Class 93: Dogs, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15", rough/broken.

<u>Class 94:</u> <u>BEST OPEN DOG & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 89-93. No entry

<u>Class 95</u>: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch. Open to any adult JR owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 96: Bitches, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", smooth

Class 97: Bitches, 1 year & over, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken.

Class 98: Bitches, 1 year & over, over 12½" up to 15", smooth

Class 99: Bitches, 1 year & over, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken.

<u>Class 100:</u> <u>BEST OPEN BITCH & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 95-99. No fee <u>Class 101:</u> <u>BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE</u>. Open to first & second place winners of classes 94 & 100. No entry fees.

DIVISION C—GO-TO-GROUND

- Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. See posted rules at event.
 *FOR ALL CLASSES; work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached, for all classes.
- Must work quarry continuously for one full minute, without a break in work, unless noted.
- No Adult terrier may compete in the Championship Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for and issued and received.
- Please be courteous; Let someone run between your dog's when you have more than one.
- <u>Copies of JRTCA GTG trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries</u> or presented to the den steward at the time of judging in all championship classes.
- Open Puppy & Open Adult, Puppy Championship classes-one second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry."
- Cross-entering is not permitted between open or certificate classes.

GTG continued

<u>Class 102</u>: Pre-Novice Puppy. Open to pups 4 up to 6 mos. Entry in this class does not affect pups' eligibility to enter Novice class after 6 mos. of age. One min. to reach quarry; mark for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached.

<u>Class 103:</u> Novice Puppy. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 months <u>which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial</u>. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial <u>may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial</u>. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

Class 104: Open Puppy. Open to JRT's 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies 6-12 months who have earned 100% in the open Puppy class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials.

OPEN PUPPY GTG IS NOT OPEN TO ANY PUPPY WHICH HAS COMPETED IN PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP GTG1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

Class: 105: Puppy GTG Championship. Open to JRT pups 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% on Open Puppy G-T-G at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of the 100% score sheet must be submitted with a pre-entry or shown to den steward at the time of the class. Puppies may move up to this class on the same day as qualifying in Open G-T-G, upon payment of additional fee. 1st. and 2nd. Place winners will be Puppy G-T-G Champion and Reserve. 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

<u>Class 106</u>: Novice Adult. Open to JRTs one year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.

<u>Class 107:</u> Open Adult. Open to adult JRTs <u>which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial</u>. 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. <u>May not move up to championship classes until certificate is in hand.</u>

GO-TO-GROUND CERTIFICATE CLASSES – NO CROSS ENTERING Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 15" who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. <u>1 second per foot of tunnel</u> to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. <u>First and second place winners will be GTG Champion & Reserve.</u>

Class 108: 10 up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate

Class 109: Over 12½ up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate

Class 110: 10 up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate

Class 111: Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate

Class 112: 10 up to 12½" Senior Championship Certificate.

Class 113: Over 12½ up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate.

DIVISION D — SUPER EARTH.

Challenging GTG course; open to any JRT 6 mos. or older.

<u>All Super Earth classes-1 second per foot of tunnel</u> to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until the quarry is reached; then must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty. A copy of the JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging.

<u>Class 114</u>: <u>Open</u> Puppy Super Earth 6 up to 12 months. Open to all 6–12-month puppies. Puppies 6-12 months who have earned 100% in the Open Puppy Super Earth Class at this trial, may upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth Class at future Trials.

OPEN PUPPY SUPER EARTH CLASS IS NOT OPEN TO ANY PUPPY WHICH HAS COMPETED IN PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP SUPER EARTH

<u>Class 115</u>: Open Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

<u>Class 116:</u> Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 117: 6 up to 12-month Puppy Champion Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 months JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 months Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class.

First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

SUPER EARTH CERTIFICATE CLASSES-- NO CROSS ENTERING

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. **First and Second Place winners will be Super Earth Champion and Reserve.**

Class 118: 10 up to 12.5" Adult Certificate Super Earth.

Class 119: Over 12.5" up to 15" Adult Certificate Super Earth

Class 120: 10 up to 12.5" Veteran Certificate Super Earth

Class 121: Over 12.5" up to 15" Veteran Certificate Super Earth

Class 122: 10 up to 12.5" Senior Certificate Super Earth

<u>Class 123:</u> Over 12.5 up to 15" Senior Certificate Super Earth



NON-SANCTIONED DIVISIONS

DIVISION F. BRUSH HUNT (non-sanctioned)

How fast can your terrier find a rat or other quarry in the brush? Your dog will be timed from release in a natural but fenced-in area where there will quarry protected by a cage yet hidden in the area. The judge will call time once the quarry is located, and the dog starts working the quarry.

Class 129: Puppies – 4 up to 6 months

Class 130: Puppies – 6 up to 12 months

Class 131: Adults Over 1 year of age

Class 132: Veterans – Over 6 years of age

Class 133: Seniors - Over 9 years of age

<u>Class 134: High Score and Reserve</u> award determined from the fastest times of the day from the classes above.

DIVISION G. LURE COURSING (Non-Sanctioned)

Your dog will be timed from release in a fenced course to chase the lure. Runs are back-to-back.

Class 136: Puppies – 6 up to 12 months, 10 up to 12.5"

Class 137: Puppies – 6 up to 12 months, over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 138: Adults - Over 1 year of age, 10 up to 12.5"

Class 139: Adults - Over 1 year of age, over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 140: Veterans – over 6 years of age, 10 up to 12.5"

Class 141: Veterans - over 6 years of age, over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 142: Seniors – over 9 years of age, 10 up to 12.5"

Class 143: Seniors - over 9 years of age, over 12.5" up to15"

<u>Class 144:</u> <u>Under Lure High Score and Reserve</u>. No entry fees. Awarded to 1st & 2nd fastest time each day from classes 136, 138, 140, 142.

<u>Class 145</u>: <u>Over Lure High Score and Reserve.</u> No entry fees. Awarded to 1st & 2nd fastest time each day from classes 137, 139, 141, 143.

DIVISION H. THUNDER TUNNEL (Non-Sanctioned)

A timed event/competition with the terrier working its way through a tunnel maze that may have dead ends and obstacles to maneuver. The tunnel has a clear side so you can see the progress of your terrier as it makes its way to the caged quarry. The terrier runs the tunnel twice; the best time is the final time that counts towards placement.

Class 146: Puppies - 4 up to 6 months

Class 147: Puppies – 6 up to 12 months

Class 148: Adults - Over 1 year of age

Class 149: Veterans – over 6 years of age

<u>Class 150:</u> Seniors - over 9 years of age

Class 151: High Score & Reserve awarded for the fastest times of the day from the classes above.

BALL TOSS open until 3PM (non-sanctioned)

Ball toss is a timed event. Three (3) tosses with the best time recorded. Ball is tossed a specific distance; dog must retrieve the ball back over the start/finish line with each toss/retrieval timed. A variety of balls will be provided, or you may use your dog's "favorite" ball.

Class 152: Puppies, 6 up to 12 months

Class 153: Adults, 1 year and older, up to 12 ½"

Class 154: Adults, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 155: Veterans, 6 years up to 9 years

Class 156: Seniors, 9 years and older

Class 157: High Score and Reserve awarded for the fastest times of the day from the classes above.

<u>Division I: Nosework</u> Nosework Classes.

LEVEL 1 Containers and Level 2 Containers will be Saturday ONLY (Class 170-171) LEVEL 1 Exterior and Level 2 Exterior will be Sunday ONLY (Class 173-174)

<u>Class 170: Level 1 Containers</u> – 8 to 10 identical containers. 1 birch hide, 1 incorrect call allowed. Time allowed 2:00 min. Team must go through start markers to start time." Alert" is called when hide is found. Faults will be assessed for dropped food, incorrect calls, not passing through start markers. NQ for fouling the ring or going over time. Placements for fastest time with no faults first. On lead

<u>Class 171: Level 2 Containers</u> There are 2 hides, can be either Birch, Anise or Clove.

In Interior or Exterior hide can be 2 feet high.

Containers can be 10 or 12 white boxes or any other container.

Time limit can be 2:30 sec. or more - judge's decision

Class 172: Champion & Reserve for combined scores from 2 classes

SUNDAY

<u>Class 173: Level 1 Exterior</u> - 1 birch hide, no higher than 12" on any object, search area is approx. 10 x 20ft. 1 incorrect called is allowed. Must go through start markers. Time allowed is the judge's decision. Can be 2:30 sec. Placement is fastest time without faults. Can be done on or off lead.

<u>Class 174: Level 2 Exterior-</u> There are 2 hides, can be either Birch, Anise or Clove. In Interior or Exterior hide can be 2 feet high.

Containers can be 10 or 12 white boxes or any other container.

Time limit can be 2:30 sec. or more - judge's decision

Class 175: Champion & Reserve for combined scores from 2 classes

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form, including a signed waiver, for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10" 15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception - Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.

- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds). (01/22)
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs, other than JRTs, on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event. (01/22)
- 24. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS
